NL Lions Club to fundraise with fashion

March 7 fashion show planned at VFW

The New Lenox Lions Club is adding some fashion to its fundraising efforts.

The club will host its first-ever fashion show Sunday, March 7, and with its "Spring Into Paris" theme the event will showcase plenty of spring fashions.

President-elect Lisa Kline wanted to do something different for a fundraiser and so came up with the idea to host the fashion show, which will be held at New Lenox VFW Post 9545, 323 Old Hickory Road. She teamed up with Cedar Closet owner Michelle Hepburn to plan the event, and Hepburn said she's excited for her first show.

"I've never done something like this before, so it's exciting," she said. "With the economy the way it is, it's great for people to be able to shop secondhand."

All the clothes featured in the show, which begins at 1:30 p.m., will come from Cedar Closet, Hepburn's upscale consignment and resale shop at 1264 N. Cedar Road. Hepburn plans to showcase a variety of looks, from casual to formal wear, including prom dresses.

"I'm being very selective about the outfits," she said. "The clothes are going to be nice, we'll feature lots of fun styles."

Hepburn said she's been volunteering with the Lions Club for the past 16 years and first became involved through friend Steve Rhodes, a past club president. She's also donating a portion of any sales from the show to the club.

Tickets to the fashion show are \$25 and include a soup and salad buffet courtesy of Gatto's Restaurant. Corporate table sponsorship is \$250. Music is being provided by Toplist Karaoke with Cheryl, and plenty of pampering will be available thanks to Healthy Connection Chiropractic and Rehab Clinic, which is offering

"We serve our community by providing food and Christmas baskets to those who need help during the holidays. We provide a spaghetti dinner for the seniors and organize the Special Need Day during Proud American Days, just to name a few."

When she is sworn in later this year, Kline will become the first female Lions Club president. She said she'll continue to serve the community and be a leader with the help of her fellow Lions.

"I hope everyone will come and join us at our first New Lenox Lions Club fashion show fundraiser," Kline said.
